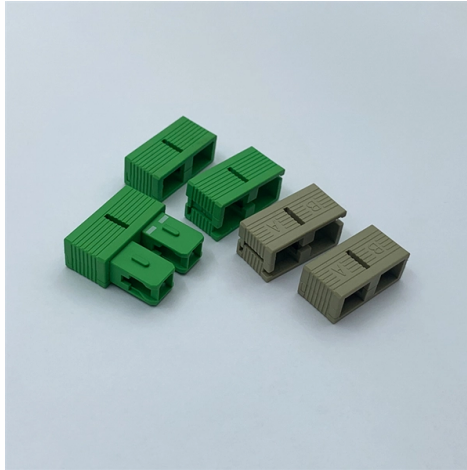


# What is a normal network speed for a 24-core fiber optic cable

- **Fiber Type:** Single-mode fiber is ideal for long distances and high-speed transmission, while multimode fiber is better for shorter distances but suffers from modal dispersion, limiting speed .
- **Distance:** Bandwidth decreases with distance due to signal attenuation. Repeaters or optical amplifiers may be required for long-haul connections .
- **Equipment:** Transceivers, multiplexers, and network switches determine the effective throughput. High-end DWDM systems can push multiple wavelengths per fiber, dramatically increasing total capacity .
