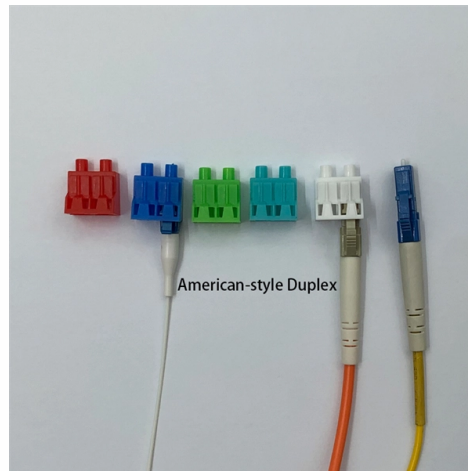


What is a one-in-three-out terminal box
