- **Device Authentication:** Before a device can access a network, its identity must be verified. This ensures that only authorized devices can connect, preventing unauthorized access or malware infiltration. Methods include passwords, digital certificates, and cryptographic key pairs .
- **Connectivity and Functionality Testing:** Tools like Ping and Traceroute are used to test whether devices are online, responsive, and correctly routing traffic. Ping checks connectivity, while Traceroute maps the path packets take, helping identify delays or failures .
