Some cables installed in the 1990s are still transmitting high-speed data effectively, while others may fail prematurely due to stress or environmental factors .

Factors Affecting Longevity

- **Installation Stress:** Excessive pulling, bending beyond the minimum bend radius, or improper splicing can create microbends or fractures in the fiber, which grow over time and reduce lifespan .
