

What is the network speed of a 100Mbps fiber optic wireless router

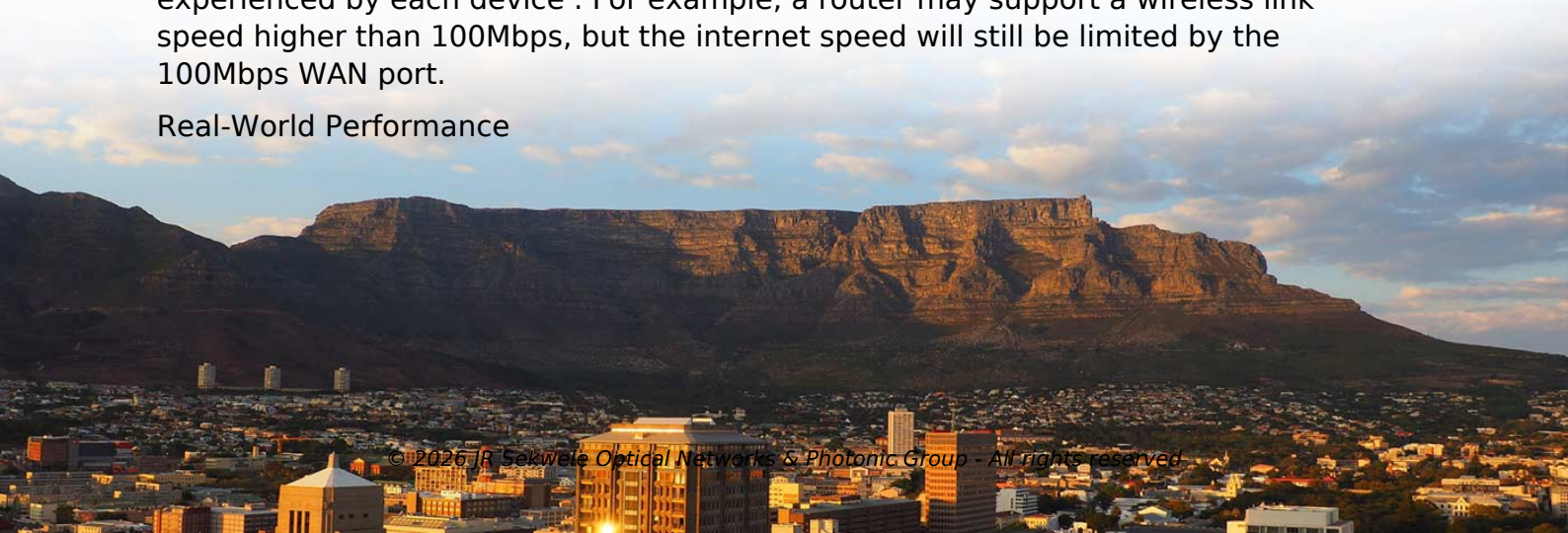
Maximum Internet Speed

A 100Mbps router is designed to handle internet speeds up to 100 megabits per second, which is the maximum throughput of its WAN port. This means that even if your fiber optic connection is capable of higher speeds, the router will cap the internet speed at 100Mbps. In practical terms, this translates to a maximum download speed of about 12.5 megabytes per second under ideal conditions.

Wireless Link Speed

The signal rate advertised on a router refers to the maximum wireless link speed between the router and connected devices, not the internet speed itself. Factors such as Wi-Fi standard (e.g., 802.11n, 802.11ac, Wi-Fi 6), distance from the router, physical obstacles, and interference from other devices can reduce the actual speed experienced by each device. For example, a router may support a wireless link speed higher than 100Mbps, but the internet speed will still be limited by the 100Mbps WAN port.
