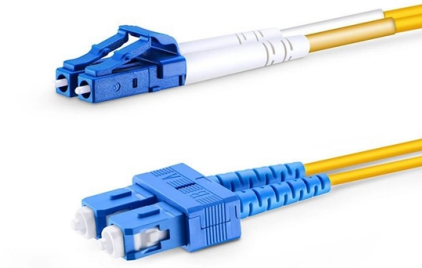

Core Components

- **Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly (TOSA):** Includes a laser diode (LD) or light-emitting diode (LED) that emits modulated light corresponding to the input electrical signal. It may also include a monitoring photodiode and an automatic power control circuit to maintain consistent output.
- **Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly (ROSA):** Contains a photodetector that converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals, often followed by a preamplifier.
- **Functional Circuits and Driver Chips:** Process electrical signals and control the modulation of the light source.
