Key Components

- Terminals or Terminal Blocks: Points where wires are securely connected using screws or clamps.
- Grounding Points: Green screws or dedicated terminals for connecting bare copper or green-insulated ground wires.
- Enclosure: Protects wires from environmental hazards and prevents accidental contact.

Wiring Steps

- Turn Off Power: Always switch off the circuit at the breaker before starting any wiring work .
