

What level of fire protection distribution box should a hotel use



Article Overview

Hotels typically require a fire protection distribution box rated for full building coverage, integrated with NFPA 13-compliant sprinkler and fire alarm systems.

Occupancy Classification and Hazard Level

Hotels are generally classified as assembly and residential occupancies under NFPA standards, which places them in a light hazard to ordinary hazard occupancy depending on the specific areas (guest rooms, kitchens, lobbies, or mechanical rooms) and the combustibility of contents . Guest rooms and corridors are usually considered light hazard, while kitchens and service areas may be ordinary hazard due to higher fire risk .

Fire Protection System Requirements

New hotel constructions require:

- Full sprinkler coverage throughout guest rooms, corridors, and common areas, designed according to NFPA 13 or NFPA 13R for low-rise buildings .
- Interconnected fire alarm systems with manual pull stations, smoke detectors, and audible/visual notification devices .
- Specialized extinguishers: Class ABC in hallways and public spaces, Class K in kitchens, and CO2 units for electrical rooms .
- Emergency lighting and exit signage with battery backup for at least 90 minutes .
