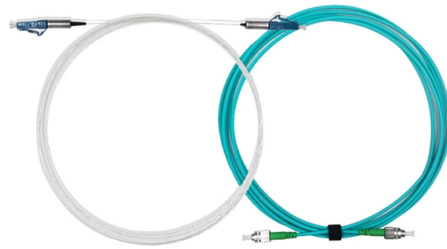


What materials are needed for grounding a distribution box

Distribution boxes are grounded using copper or copper-clad steel conductors connected to rods or plates, ensuring low-resistance paths for fault currents.

Grounding Conductors

The primary materials for grounding conductors include bare or tinned copper, copper-clad steel, and corrosion-resistant conductors. These conductors connect the distribution box to the grounding electrodes and ensure a continuous low-resistance path for fault currents. For example, in the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) copper wire is commonly used, while in other markets, a 6 mm² copper conductor is standard. Larger conductors, such as 16 mm² or 6 AWG, may be used for longer runs or multiple connections to maintain low resistance.

Grounding Electrodes

Grounding electrodes are typically copper rods, copper-bonded steel rods, or grounding plates. These are driven into the soil near the distribution box to provide a stable earth connection. The number and placement of rods depend on soil resistivity and desired ground resistance, with multiple rods connected by a continuous conductor if a single rod does not achieve the required resistance. Approved conductive backfill, such as bentonite clay, may be used to improve contact in high-resistivity soils.
