

What size should the cable tray bolts be



Article Overview

Cable trays typically use M8 high-tensile bolts with nuts and washers, with 8 hardware sets per joint for standard GI or perforated trays.

Bolt Types and Sizes

For standard perforated or GI cable trays, the following specifications are commonly used:

- Bolt Size: M8 (metric 8 mm diameter) high-tensile bolts .
- Length: Minimum 75 mm for wall-mounted supports; length may vary depending on tray thickness and support structure .
- Hardware Sets: Each joint between two cable tray sections typically uses 8 sets of bolts, nuts, and washers when using coupler plates .
- Nut Type: Serrated flange locknuts are recommended for splice connections to prevent loosening .
- Washers: Flat washers are used to distribute load and protect the tray surface. High-strength washers are preferred for structural integrity .

Splice and Coupler Plates

- Splice Plates: Made of high-strength steel, meeting ASTM A1011 HSLAS, Grade 50, Class 1 .
- Bolt Arrangement: 8 bolts per splice plate for standard straight sections; wedge lock 4-bolt or 2-bolt KwikRail connections are UL-classified as equipment ground conductors .
