

What size support should the cable tray be paired with



Article Overview

Cable tray supports should be sized based on tray type, load, span, and environmental conditions, following manufacturer specifications and NEC/IEC guidelines.

Support Spacing Guidelines

The spacing between cable tray supports depends on the tray type, material, and anticipated load. For horizontal runs, the NEC recommends supports at intervals not exceeding 5 feet, with an ideal range of 4 to 6 feet for uniform load distribution and structural stability . Ladder-type trays have rungs spaced no more than 9 inches apart, which also affects support requirements . Aluminum trays generally require closer spacing (1.5–2.0 meters) due to lower stiffness, while steel trays can span 2.0–3.0 meters .

Support Material and Size

Supports can be angle steel, trapeze hangers, or cantilever brackets, selected based on the building structure and tray route . The size of the support must accommodate the maximum anticipated load, including cable weight, environmental factors (wind, seismic activity), and any accidental impacts. Safety factors typically range from 1.5 to 2.0, with higher values for industrial or critical infrastructure applications . Stainless steel is recommended for corrosive or high-humidity environments, while galvanized steel is sufficient for most indoor dry applications .
