

What size wire should the electrical panel in your home have

For typical household circuits, 14 AWG wire is used for 15-amp circuits, 12 AWG for 20-amp circuits, and 10 AWG for 30-amp circuits.

General Guidelines for Residential Wiring

- 15-amp circuits: Use 14 AWG copper wire, typically for general lighting and low-power outlets. This is the minimum wire size allowed in modern residential construction and is protected by a 15-amp breaker .
- 20-amp circuits: Use 12 AWG copper wire, standard for kitchen, bathroom, and garage outlets, as well as small appliance circuits. These circuits are protected by 20-amp breakers .
- 30-amp circuits: Use 10 AWG copper wire, commonly for electric dryers, water heaters, and window air conditioners, paired with a 30-amp breaker .

Larger Appliances and High-Demand Circuits

- Electric ranges and ovens: Typically require 6–8 AWG wire with a 40–50 amp breaker depending on the appliance rating .
- Electric water heaters: Usually installed on a 10 AWG wire with a 30-amp breaker .
- Central AC units or large HVAC systems: May require 6 AWG or larger depending on amperage and distance from the panel .
