

What to do if the telecommunications fiber optic cable is moved

Moving a fiber optic cable requires careful planning, proper handling, and adherence to minimum bend radius and tension limits to avoid damage and maintain performance.

Planning the Move

Before relocating a fiber optic cable, assess the route from the current location to the new one, noting obstacles, sharp turns, and potential hazards. Ensure the work area is clear and safe, and gather necessary equipment such as corner rollers, grooved rollers, fish tape, and cable-pulling lubricant to facilitate smooth movement without stressing the cable. Contact your service provider in advance to coordinate the move, confirm any fees, and ensure compliance with their guidelines.

Handling and Routing

Fiber optic cables are delicate and can be damaged by sharp bends or excessive tension. Always maintain the minimum bending radius specified by the manufacturer, using corner rollers for turns and grooved rollers when pulling alongside other cables to prevent tangling. Continuously monitor pulling tension to avoid exceeding the maximum allowed, which could break the glass fibers or degrade signal quality. Avoid routing near heat sources, high-traffic areas, or abrasive surfaces that could compromise the cable jacket.
