

What type of device is an optical coupler

An optical coupler is an optical device used to split or combine light signals between two or more optical fibers.

Definition and Function

An optical coupler, also known as a fiber optic coupler, is a device that connects multiple optical fibers, allowing light from one input fiber to be distributed to multiple output fibers or combining light from multiple fibers into a single output fiber . It is commonly used in fiber optic networks to manage signal distribution, merging, or routing without converting the optical signal to an electrical signal.

Types of Optical Couplers

Optical couplers can be classified based on their function and construction:

- **Directional Couplers:** Designed so that light entering an input port is transferred primarily to the output ports with minimal reflection back to the input .
- **Splitters and Combiners:** Splitters divide one input signal into multiple outputs, while combiners merge multiple input signals into one output .
- **Passive vs. Active Couplers:** Passive couplers operate without external power, using fused fibers, micro-lenses, or beam splitters to redirect light. Active couplers require power and may include detectors and light sources to manage signals .
