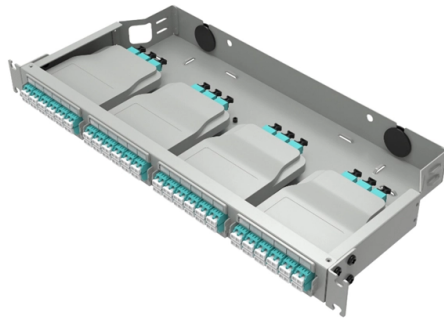


Where should the grounding of a residential electrical distribution box be connected



Article Overview

The grounding of a residential electrical distribution box should be connected from the panel's grounding bus bar to a grounding electrode, such as a metal rod driven into the earth or a metal water pipe in contact with the ground.

Main Connection Points

- **Grounding Bus Bar:** Inside the main electrical panel, locate the grounding bus bar, typically green or bare metal. This is where all ground wires from circuits terminate and where the grounding electrode conductor (GEC) is attached ().
- **Grounding Electrode:** The GEC runs from the grounding bus bar to a grounding electrode. Common electrodes include:
 - **Ground Rod:** A copper-clad or galvanized steel rod, at least 8 feet long, driven vertically into the earth near the panel ().
 - **Metal Underground Water Pipe:** Must be in direct contact with the earth for at least 10 feet; only metallic pipes can serve as a reliable ground ().
 - **Concrete-Encased Electrode (Ufer Ground):** Metal rebar or copper wire encased in concrete footing can also serve as a grounding electrode ().
- **Main Bonding Jumper (MBJ):** In the main service panel, the neutral bus bar is bonded to the grounding bus bar using the MBJ. This ensures that fault currents have a low-impedance path back to the source, allowing breakers to trip during a fault ().
