

Where to plug in the single-mode fiber optic module



Article Overview

A single-mode SFP module plugs into the SFP or SFP+ port on compatible network devices such as switches, routers, or media converters, ensuring the port matches the module's fiber type and wavelength.

Connecting the Module

Single-mode SFP transceivers are hot-swappable optical modules designed to transmit and receive data over single-mode fiber (SMF) using laser light, typically at 1310nm or 1550nm wavelengths . To install:

- Locate the SFP/SFP+ port on your network device. These ports are usually labeled and may be grouped together on switches or routers .
- Check compatibility: Ensure the port supports the SFP module type (e.g., 1G, 10G) and that the module is certified for your device .
- Insert the module: Align the SFP module with the port and gently push until it clicks into place. The module connects the device's electrical circuitry to the optical network .
- Connect the fiber cable: Use a fiber patch cable with the correct connector type (commonly LC for single-mode SFPs) and ensure the TX (transmit) and RX (receive) ends are correctly oriented .

Important Considerations

- Fiber type: Single-mode SFPs are designed for SMF with a small core ($\sim 9/125\mu\text{m}$) and long-distance transmission. Do not use multimode fiber with a single-mode SFP .
