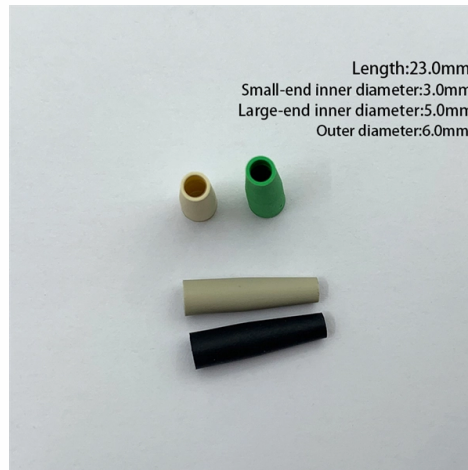


# Which cable tray should the surveillance composite cable run through

\*Quick Answer: For most security system installations, we recommend solid-bottom cable trays with covers made from hot-dip galvanized steel for indoor applications or aluminum for outdoor/EMI-sensitive environments. Follow the 40% fill rule and always separate power from data.
