Fiber Color Coding Overview

Fiber optic cables use a standardized color code to identify individual fibers, which is essential for splicing, termination, and maintenance. The TIA/EIA-598-C standard defines a sequence of 12 colors for the first 12 fibers in a cable:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green
- Brown
- Slate (Gray)
- White
- Red
- Black
- Yellow
- Violet (Purple)
