A fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber cable with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, designed for splicing into a fiber optic network.

Definition and Structure

A fiber optic pigtail is typically a short length of optical fiber, usually between 0.5 to 2 meters, with a factory-installed connector on one end and an exposed bare fiber on the other end . The connector end is polished and tested under controlled conditions to ensure low insertion loss and high return loss, while the bare fiber end is intended for fusion or mechanical splicing to a fiber optic cable in the field .

Differences from Patch Cords

Unlike a fiber patch cord, which has connectors on both ends for direct connectivity between devices, a pigtail has only one connector. This design allows the pigtail to be spliced to bulk fiber cables, making it ideal for terminating fibers at optical distribution frames (ODFs), patch panels, or terminal boxes . Patch cords are generally used for connecting pre-terminated devices, whereas pigtails are used for field termination and network integration.
