High temperatures increase conductor resistance, further contributing to voltage drop and energy loss . **Electromagnetic Interference (EMI):** Placing power cables close to control or communication lines can induce interference, leading to signal degradation and data loss . **Mechanical Stress and Sagging:** Improper support or excessive spans cause cable sag, which can strain connections and increase contact resistance, indirectly contributing to wire loss . **Environmental Factors:** Corrosion, moisture, and chemical exposure can degrade cable insulation and conductor quality, increasing resistance and energy loss .
