Copper or aluminum conductors with proper insulation such as THHN, THWN, or THWN-2 are commonly used in three-level distribution boxes, along with dedicated neutral and earth wires.

Types of Wires

- Phase Conductors (Live Wires)
 - Typically copper or aluminum conductors are used for the three phases (L1, L2, L3) in a three-phase distribution box .
 - Insulation types: THHN (thermoplastic high-heat nylon-coated), THWN (thermoplastic heat- and water-resistant), or THWN-2 (dual-rated for wet and dry conditions) are standard .
 - Color coding: Black, red, and blue are standard for live wires to ensure compliance with NEC and simplify troubleshooting .
- Neutral Wire
 - A dedicated neutral conductor is required to carry return current.
 - Typically white or gray insulated copper wire is used .
 - Neutral wires should not be shared between separate sets of circuits to prevent voltage imbalance .
- Ground/Earth Wire
 - Provides safety by redirecting fault current to the earth.
