

Wiring of terminal block distribution box

Proper wiring of terminal blocks ensures safe, reliable, and maintainable electrical connections in distribution boxes.

Selecting the Right Terminal Block

Choose a terminal block based on current and voltage ratings, wire size, and environmental conditions such as temperature, humidity, and vibration. Screw-type terminals are ideal for higher currents and long-term reliability, while push-in (spring clamp) terminals allow faster, tool-free installation and resist vibration. Ensure the block complies with IEC 60947-7-1 and UL 1059 standards for safety.

Preparing the Wires

- Turn off power to the circuit before starting.
- Cut wires to the appropriate length, leaving enough slack for maintenance but avoiding clutter.
- Strip insulation from the wire ends according to manufacturer specifications, typically 6–12 mm (1/4"–1/2").
- For stranded wires, use ferrules to prevent stray strands and ensure a secure connection.

Mounting Terminal Blocks

- Snap the terminal block onto the DIN rail at the designated position; you should hear or feel a click when properly seated.
