- Identify relay types (current, voltage, impedance, differential, distance, directional) and their operating characteristics.
- Determine cable routing, terminal strip locations, and panel layout to facilitate maintenance and testing.
- Cable Selection and Color Coding
- Use multicore cables with standard color codes for AC, DC, and control circuits.
