Input Wiring (Before the Distribution Box)

The wiring that comes into the distribution box from the main power source is called the input wiring. This includes the phase (live), neutral, and ground wires. Proper input wiring ensures that the distribution box receives stable power and that all internal components, such as circuit breakers and fuses, function correctly. Input wires should be connected to the designated terminals according to color coding and tightened securely to prevent loose connections, which could cause short circuits or arcing .

Output Wiring (After the Distribution Box)

The wiring that leaves the distribution box to supply power to different circuits is called output wiring. Each branch circuit should be connected to its respective breaker or fuse, following the principle: phase wire to phase terminal, neutral to neutral terminal, and ground to ground terminal. Output wiring should be neatly arranged, secured with cable ties, and spaced to allow heat dissipation. Proper output wiring ensures that electricity is safely and efficiently delivered to all connected devices .
