Key Components for Live Wire Connections

- **Main Breaker or Main Isolator:** Acts as the primary disconnect for the entire system. Live wires from the incoming supply are first routed to the main breaker, which allows you to safely cut off power during maintenance or emergencies .
- **Busbars:** Solid metal bars, usually copper, that distribute power to branch circuit breakers. Live wires from the main breaker are connected to the busbar, which then feeds each branch breaker. Using a comb busbar ensures uniform distribution and reduces wiring clutter .
- **Branch Circuit Breakers:** Each live wire for a specific circuit is connected to the input terminal of its corresponding breaker. A single-pole breaker interrupts only the live conductor, while the neutral wire connects to the neutral bar .
- **Terminal Blocks:** Modular terminals, such as screw, spring, or push-in types, provide secure connections for live wires. They help organize wiring, prevent loose connections, and allow easy maintenance or future upgrades . Push-in terminals, like WAGO's CAGE CLAMP®, are particularly useful for solid and stranded conductors, offering reliable contact and time-saving installation .
